## **ORDER**

- 1. the application for judicial review is granted;
- 2. the part of Order F08-10 of the Delegate of the Information and Privacy Commissioner for British Columbia, dated May 21, 2008, that relates to and requires the Board of Education of School District No. 69 (Qualicum) to give access to information in record 262 (the "grievance records"), is set aside on the ground that s. 21(1) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 165, requires the Board of Education of School District No. 69 (Qualicum) to refuse access; and
- 3. no costs are ordered.
