Commissioner Denham receives PACC Fellowship Award

VICTORIA—The Privacy and Access Council of Canada (PACC) has announced that Commissioner Elizabeth Denham is a recipient of the 2016 PACC Fellowship Award, which recognizes industry leaders who have made significant contributions to information and access-to-information in Canada.

The award was presented on April 1 at the National Privacy & Data Governance Congress 2016, a two-day event to increase awareness about the intersection of privacy, security, law and technology.
