OIPC Deputy Commissioner Jay Fedorak confirmed as new Information Commissioner for Jersey in the British Channel Islands

VICTORIA—BC's Information and Privacy Commissioner Michael McEvoy issued the following statement:

"This morning the Office of the Information Commissioner for Jersey confirmed the appointment of Jay Fedorak as the incoming Information Commissioner for Jersey, effective July 2, 2018.

"Deputy Commissioner Fedorak joined my office in 2004 and has served as Deputy Commissioner and Deputy Registrar since 2012.

"As the Information Commissioner for Jersey, Fedorak will regulate the public and private sector, enforce the new *Data Protection Law*, and assist the island in maintaining adequacy with the European Union's GDPR.

"On behalf of the OIPC, I congratulate Jay on this exciting appointment," said McEvoy.
