Commissioner to audit Insurance Corporation of British Columbia's information sharing agreements

VICTORIA—Acting Information and Privacy Commissioner Drew McArthur has determined that the office will audit information sharing agreements of the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC).

ICBC discloses personal information of BC citizens with a number of public bodies and private sector organizations. Auditors will review these agreements to determine if ICBC policies and practices are compliant with the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* (FIPPA).

A final report will be made public upon completion of the audit. A timeline for this project has not yet been determined.
