Commissioner to release findings of compliance review of private sector liquor and cannabis retailers' privacy practices

VICTORIA—On Tuesday, June 22, 2021 at 9:30am, Information and Privacy Commissioner Michael McEvoy will release the results of a compliance review of private sector liquor and cannabis retailers' privacy management programs.

Auditors examined whether 30 liquor and cannabis retailers have processes and procedures in place to manage the personal information of customers and employees, as required by the *Personal Information Protection Act*.
