Pursuant to section 49 of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act* ("FIPPA"), I delegate to each person who holds a position identified in the attached Delegate Schedule, the powers in the *E-Health (Personal Health Information Access and Protection of Privacy) Act* as set out in that schedule.

This delegation may be revoked or amended by an instrument signed by me.

This delegation is effective from the date below and ceases to be effective on the earlier of the date:

- it is revoked by a document signed by me;
- the delegate ceases to be employed in the OIPC; or
- the delegate begins a leave of absence or temporary assignment from the Office.

In the case of a leave of absence or temporary assignment, this delegation becomes effective again on the date on which the delegate resumes employment in the office.

This delegation overrides all delegations previously given to persons under FIPPA.
