## **Information and Privacy Commissioner to release report about the City of Vancouver's FOI program**

**VICTORIA**—On Thursday, June 23, at 9:30 a.m., B.C. Information and Privacy Commissioner Elizabeth Denham will release a report entitled *Audit & Compliance Report F16-01: City of Vancouver Duty to Assist*.

The report reviews the City of Vancouver's duty to assist applicants in exercising their access rights. The Commissioner chose the City of Vancouver as the subject of the review as the City manages the largest volume of FOI requests compared to any other municipality.
