## Commissioner to release findings of investigation into over-collection of personal information by landlords

**VICTORIA**—On Thursday, March 22, 2018 at 9:30 am, Acting Information and Privacy Commissioner Drew McArthur will release the results of an investigation into the overcollection of personal information by landlords in BC.

The investigation examined the personal information collected from prospective tenants by landlords in British Columbia. Landlords and not-for-profit organizations that provide rental housing are subject to BC's *Personal Information Protection Act*.
